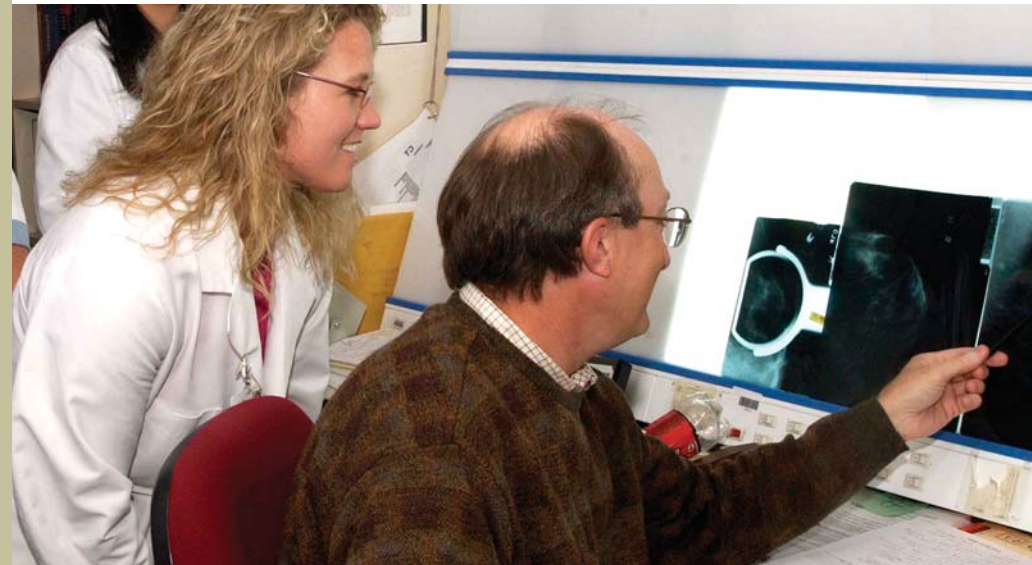


Osteopathic medicine is founded on the philosophy to treat people, not just their symptoms. While this "total patient" approach to health care was pioneered over 125 years ago, DOs are more relevant today than ever, because of patients' desire for comprehensive, compassionate primary care and a focus on prevention and wellness. Dayton area Osteopathic physicians care for a quarter million people – 25% of our population – with over one million annual visits.

GRANDVIEW – A TEACHING HOSPITAL

The Foundation enhances the important role of Grandview as a teaching hospital serving the Dayton community. Grandview Medical Center is one of the largest Osteopathic health care systems in the nation and is home to the country's second largest, and nationally recognized, Graduate Medical Education program.

Each academic year, Grandview and Southview Hospitals welcome 300 third and fourth year medical students for rotations; an internship class of 30; and 75 new and returning residents and fellows. Grandview's training program is led by physician-educators who donate their time and talent to train health care providers for the future. Over the past 50 years, more than one thousand physicians have completed their training at Grandview Medical Center. The majority of these physicians stay in the Dayton region to care for their community.





GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION

The Foundation is an important resource for Grandview's Graduate Medical Education program. Grandview Medical Education program provides a premier training ground for tomorrow's Osteopathic physicians. Grandview's broad scope of residency programs include: Anesthesiology, Emergency Medicine, ENT, Family Practice, Internal Medicine, Neurology, Neurosurgery, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Ophthalmology, Orthopedic Surgery, Proctology, General Surgery, and Vascular Medicine. Grandview also provides fellowship opportunities in the areas of Vascular Surgery, Nephrology, Sleep Medicine and Cardiology.

CASSANO HEALTH CENTER

At Grandview's Cassano Health Center, comprehensive health care is provided to the medically underserved in the Dayton community. Every patient who enters our doors is treated with respect, dignity and the highest quality medical care, regardless of their ability to pay for treatment. Our patients enter into an ongoing relationship with a primary care provider, stimulating a cycle of wellness for them and their families. Importantly, the Cassano Health Center significantly reduces the number of visits patients make to Emergency Departments across the Dayton region.



Cassano is home to Grandview's Family Practice Residency, and offers a superb physician teaching staff and graduate medical education training experience. In addition to family practice, patients also have access to resident and attending specialists during weekly clinics at the Center. Services at the Cassano Center include a full-service pharmacy, clinical laboratory and diagnostic imaging. Cassano also has a full-time social worker, a full-time Spanish interpreter for our growing Hispanic patient base, and a number of support and education groups for patients.

RENAISSANCE – REVITALIZING THE BEST VIEW IN TOWN

Grandview Hospital is an anchor in one of Dayton's most unique and historic neighborhoods. Positioned atop Grafton Hill, along with other major institutions including the Dayton Art Institute, Masonic Temple and Greek Orthodox Church, Grandview is helping to lead a revitalization of the Grafton Hill, Five Oaks and Riverdale neighborhoods.
